



Exclusion Policy (F0.0)

Control of communicable disease should be everyone's primary concern.

Policies and guidelines related to outbreaks of communicable diseases and illnesses in this facility have been developed with the help of the local health department and local pediatricians in order to protect the group as a whole as well as the health of your own child. We ask that parents assist by keeping sick children at home. **If they have or have experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 24-hours they need to be kept at home.**

- A fever of 100° by mouth or forehead scan, or 99° under the arm.
- Signs of a newly developed cough or a severe cough.
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or an upset stomach.
- Unusual or unexplained loss of appetite, fatigue, irritability, or headache.
- Any discharge or drainage from the eyes, nose, ears, or open sores.
- Live head lice/nits or scabies.

Children who show signs or symptoms listed above will be returned home ASAP. We appreciate your cooperation with this policy.
